- Yummy treats.

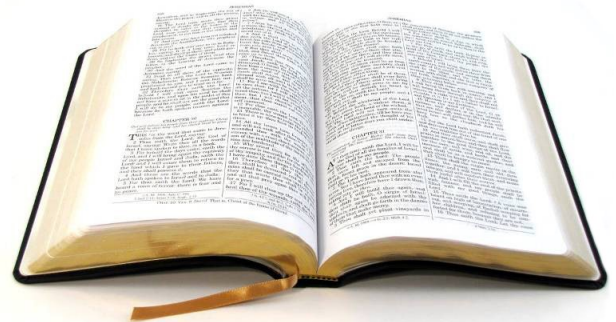
