Philippians 1:3-8 3 I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, 4 always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, 5 because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now. 6 And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. 7 It is right for me to feel this way about you all, because I hold you in my heart, for you are all partakers with me of grace, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel. 8 For God is my witness, how I yearn for you all with the affection of Christ Jesus.

Why does Paul love the churches in Philippi? Paul worked in Philippi from the beginning of the Gospel being planted. Paul saw the work of God through the Holy Spirit manifesting growth in the church. Paul has seen commitment, submission, and transformation in people. He loved these people because he knew these people. He knew what they were before they met Jesus. He saw Jesus transform them.

When the Gospel works transformation individually more love for the collective will be demonstrated. When grace is experienced collectively, love for everyone flows naturally. Do you need more love for the church? Do you need more love for people? See the work of God in the past. See the work of God in the present. Look at the transformation in people. Love will flow.
